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Naval Regimental System (NRS)

1. The Naval Regimental System (NRS) has been functional since Dec 10 to provide support to spouse/ NoK/ dependents after the demise of naval personnel irrespective of the time of the incident i.e. whether it occurred whilst in harness or after retirement. NRS has now emerged as a platform where issues pertaining to widows/NOK are being dealt with in a speedy manner. Command Regimental System Officers (CRSO) have been appointed at Command Headquarters. To cover the areas that are not in immediate vicinity of Command Headquarters, additional officers have been appointed as CRSOs. Details of CRSOs as per the geographical responsibility are given below:-

DESA Updates

2. <u>Jeevan Pramaan/ Digital Life Certificate Services at the Doorstep of the</u> <u>Pensioners through India Post Payment Bank (IPPB)</u>. India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) has established a national network of more than 1,36,000 access points in Post Offices and more than 1,89,000 Postman & Gramin Dak Sevaks with smartphones and biometric devices

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to provide doorstep banking services. Postmen and Gramin Dak Sevaks can generate Jeevan Pramaan/ Digital Life certificate at the doorstep. Dept of Posts letter D.O No. 5-4/2019-PBI dated 04 Nov 2020 is uploaded on DESA website.

3. A large number of cases are received at DESA, wherein post the demise of the veteran, widows find it difficult to get the pension. The reason could be as simple as mismatch of name/ date of birth in PPO and PAN card or even sometimes the name is not included in the PPO. Same is the case for eligible children. All veterans are requested to check for the following, and take corrective actions if required :-

(a) Name of spouse is included in PPO along with her date of birth.

(b) Name and Date of Birth of spouse in PPO is same as that in PAN and Aadhar card.

(c) Pension account is a joint account between pensioner and spouse.

(d) Dependent Identity card for spouse and dependents is made from respective Zila Sainik Board.

(e) Particulars of children are updated in Record office.

(f) Maintain a file with all important documents and ensure that spouse/ family members are aware of its location and particulars.

4. Check off lists and forms for various contingencies are available on DESA website.

5. <u>Articles for NWWA E-Chronicles</u>. To encourage creative writing skills of our naval Community, an online magazine – 'NWWA e-Chronicles' has been started which is posted on the NWWA website. NWWA letter NWWA/71/E-Vir-21(ii) in this regard has been uploaded on DESA website.

6. **<u>28th AGM</u>**. The 28th AGM of Navy Foundation was held through Video Conference on 29 Jan 21. Minutes of Meeting of 28th AGM have been uploaded on DESA website.

Veteran Sailors' Forum

7. All the retirees post Oct 2017 automatically become the members of VSF. They have been clubbed into VSF groups on WhatsApp. All important information wrt ESM including various job opportunities are being regularly disseminated through these Whatsapp groups, in addition to DESA and INPA websites.

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8. <u>Sponsorship Scheme to Join Indian Navy as Sailor</u>. Naval personnel (serving/ retired) and widows of Naval personnel who died whilst in service/ after retirement, may sponsor one candidate per batch for recruitment as a sailor. IHQMoD(N) letter NR/0101/03/RECT/POLICY dated 01 Jun 17 has been posted on DESA website. Procedure for Recruitment of Sponsored Candidates is as follows :-

(a) <u>**Categories of Sponsored Candidate**</u>. The categories of Naval personnel whose sons are eligible for sponsorship scheme in decreasing order of priority are as follows:-

- (i) Battle Casualty/ Accident.
- (ii) Died whilst in service.
- (iii) In service.
- (iv) Retired/ Died after retirement.

(b) <u>**Battle Casualties/ Accidents</u>**. Sons of Naval personnel under battle casualties/ battle accidents/ sea/ air raid casualties who satisfy all eligibility conditions may be given instant enrolment as SSR/MR. The candidate is required to fulfil minimum educational qualification for respective entry. They will be enrolled without appearing in the examination provided they qualify PFT and medical examination. Such candidates will be also be entitled for relaxation in age up to 12 months.</u>

(c) **<u>Died whilst in Service</u>**. The sons of Naval personnel who died whilst in service may be sponsored by the widow of the naval personnel. Such candidates will also be entitled for relaxation in age up to 12 months. Special relaxations for sons of Naval personnel who died whilst in service are as follows:-

(i) **SSR Entry**. Sons of Naval personnel (who die whilst in service), with 50% or above marks in 10+2/ equivalent with Physics and Maths and at least one of the optional subject of Chemistry/ Biology/ Computer Science will be enrolled without appearing in the examination provided they qualify the PFT and medical examination. However, candidates with below 50% marks in 10+2/ equivalent with Physics and Maths and at least one of the optional subject of Chemistry/ Biology/ Computer Science will have to appear and pass the written examination, PFT and medical examination. He will be awarded additional 08 marks above those obtained in the written examination. Alternatively such candidates will have the option of applying for MR entry.

(ii) <u>MR Entry</u>. Sons of Naval personnel (who die whilst in service), who have passed 10+2 / equivalent with Physics and Maths and at least one of the

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optional subject of Chemistry/ Biology/ Computer Science with less than 50% marks or who have passed in Matric/ equivalent with more than 50% marks, will be enrolled directly as MR (Chef/ Steward/ Hygienist) without appearing in the examination, provided they qualify the PFT and medical examination. However, candidates with below 50% marks in 10+2/ equivalent will have to appear and pass the written examination, PFT and medical examination. The candidate will be awarded additional 08 marks above those obtained in the written examination.

(d) **In Service**. Sons of serving Naval personnel, who have qualified 10+2 or equivalent with Physics & Mathematics and at least one of the optional subject of Chemistry/ Biology/ Computer Science are eligible for SSR entry. They will be called to appear for written examination irrespective of qualifying cut off percentage of the respective State. Such candidates will also be entitled for relaxation in age up to 06 months and will be awarded additional 05 marks above those obtained in the written examination.

(e) <u>Retired/ Died after Retirement</u>. Sons of Naval personnel (retired/ died after retirement), who have qualified 10+2 or equivalent with Physics & Mathematics and at least one of the optional subject of Chemistry/ Biology/ Computer Science are eligible for SSR entry. They will be called to appear for written examination irrespective of qualifying cut off percentage of the respective State. Such candidates will also be entitled for relaxation in age up to 04 months and will be awarded additional 05 marks above those obtained in the written examination.

9. **Sponsorship Form**. The Sponsorship form is to be uploaded whilst filling up of online application. The Sponsorship Form is to be countersigned by the Commanding Officer (for Serving Naval Personnel) or Secretary Zila Sainik Board/ DESA/ CRSO (for others). Certificate "To Whom-so-Ever It May Concern" instead of Sponsorship Form will not be acceptable.

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10. **Procedure for Sponsorship Candidates**. The procedure for sponsoring candidates is as mentioned below:-

11. <u>11th GCM/AGM of Veteran Sailors' Forum</u>. RGC North AGM of VSF was scheduled on 05 Apr 20 at Delhi. In view of the restrictions improved for COVID-19 the Annual General Body Meeting is yet to be conducted. Dates will be promulgated as and when the situation improves.

12. <u>Membership – Navy Foundation and Veteran Sailors' Forum</u>. Navy Foundation and Veteran Sailors' Forum meetings cover a large number of issues. In addition to the veterans, a large number of senior serving officers attend these meeting to resolve the issues being faced by veterans. These meetings, therefore, serve as an important link and channel of communication between the retired and the serving. During the 11th VSF GCM it was decided to increase the membership of VSF Members. It is therefore, requested non-member naval ESMs be encouraged to become members of the VSF as also that of NF.

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Indian Naval Placement Agency

13. INPA has handled a total of 3,14,300 job vacancies (3,14,201 from Monster.com and 99 received directly at INPA), since 01 Jan 21. Based on feedback from users, INPA website has been modified to ensure that users receive accurately matched jobs through emails. The profile pages are also being modified to enable faster creation/ updation of user profiles.

14. <u>Reservation for Ex-Servicemen in Assam Rifles and CAPFs</u>. Assam Rifles letter I.11011/ESM/Rect Branch/ 2021/170 dated 18 Feb 2021 has been uploaded on the DESA website.

<u>ECHS</u>

15. <u>Reimbursement of Medicines – Special Sanction in view of COVID-19</u>. Central Organisation, ECHS letter B/49761/AG/ECHS dated 16 Apr 21 has been uploaded on DESA website.

16. <u>Extension of Validity – Temporary Slips</u>. The validity of system generated Temporary Slips has been extended from three months to six months. In case the beneficiary does not receive his card within the stipulated period, the parent Polyclinic can further extend the validity for a period of three months at a time. These temporary slips are to be handed over to Station HQ at the time of collection of cards. Validity of Temporary slip for ECHS beneficiaries can be extended till 31 Jul 21 by Oi/c PC:-

17. <u>Advisory Regarding Administration of COVID Vaccine to the ECHS Beneficiaries</u> <u>at Polyclinics</u>. Central Organisation, ECHS letter B/49762/AG/ECHS/Med/2021 dated 04 Jun 21 has been uploaded on DESA Website.

18. <u>Claiming of Medical Bills for Symptomatic COVID-19 ECHS Beneficiaries who</u> <u>are RT PCR/ RAT Negative</u>. Claims for re-imbursement under this category will be reimbursed as per the State notified rates for treatment of COVID – 19. Central Organisation, ECHS letter B/49761/AG/ECHS dated 06 May 21 has been uploaded on DESA Website.

19. <u>Guidelines for Claiming Reimbursement of Home Isolation Service Package-</u> <u>COVID 19</u>. Central Organisation, ECHS letter B/49761/AG/ECHS dated 30 Apr 21 has been uploaded on DESA Website.

20. <u>New ECHS Smart Cards</u>. Online application system for ECHS Smart Cards was inaugurated on 14 Jan 18 (Armed Forces Veterans Day) by the Hon'ble RRM. The procedure

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for application of Smart Cards has been simplified (e.g. requirement of affidavit for dependents, discharge/ service book, Part II orders for adding dependents, birth certificates of dependents etc. are no longer required). Hand-holding of veterans for the purpose of filling up these application forms is being carried out at all Polyclinics. Printing and delivery of ECHS Smart Cards to Station HQs has recommenced in Jul 18 and is an ongoing process.

21. <u>New 64 Kb ECHS Card</u>. These category of beneficiaries have the facility to download temporary slip once they login using their login credentials. These temporary slips are valid for six months in the first stage and have to be authenticated by the OIC of their respective parent polyclinic. However, for veterans who have not received the new 64 Kb ECHS cards and getting entitled medical cover using online temporary slip, the validity of these temporary slips have been extended to 30 Jun 2021. Validity of Temporary slip for ECHS beneficiaries can be extended till 31 Jul 21 by Oi/c PC.

22. <u>White Cards</u>. As per existing provisions, White Card holders are given priority treatment at all ECHS polyclinics, from reception to attendance by doctors and for issue of medicines. The following are eligible for white cards:-

- (a) War Disabled/ Battle Casualty Veterans.
- (b) Spouses of War Disabled/ Battle Casualty Veterans.

23. **Treatment under AYUSH**. Govt. has authorised treatment under AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy) for all ECHS beneficiaries. Treatment in Govt. AYUSH hospitals is permitted on reimbursement basis at full rates, including the cost of prescribed medicines. For treatment under the scheme prior permission of OIC of the Polyclinic or Director, Regional Centre or CO ECHS, for a particular disease is to be obtained. It may please be noted that only one system of treatment is allowed at any point in time.

24. <u>ECHS Application for Android App</u>. ECHS has launched an Android based application for beneficiaries and this app is available on the Google Play Store for free download. Various facilities such as status of application, booking of appointment with the doctor, medical history of the patient, contacting the doctor in an emergency etc. have been made available in the application.

25. <u>Actions in Case of 'Forgot Password'</u>. A number of veterans tend to forget passwords, which they have created for 'logging-in' to the ECHS website during the process of online registration. Earlier, there was no facility to retrieve/ reset it. A system has now been

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instituted, wherein by sending an email (with minor details like Name, Number, etc) from the registered email id, the password can be reset by the beneficiary.

26. <u>**Revert Application**</u>. At times, there could be some inadvertent mistakes, both, from ECHS applicant while filling the application and also from the Record Offices verifying these applications. In order to tide over the issue, a facility of Revert Application has been provided in the system, wherein the primary beneficiary can log-in and change the incorrectly filled data. This facility would be feasible only till such time that the card has not been printed.

27. <u>Handing Over of ECHS Smart Cards to ECHS Beneficiaries</u>. Central Organisation, ECHS letter No. B/49711-IT/AG/ECHS/Gen Corr dated 11 Nov 20 & B/49711-IT/AG/ECHS/Gen Corr dated 11 Mar 21 has been uploaded on DESA Website.

28. **Grant of ECHS Facilities to SSCOs and Non Pensioner Pre-Mature Retirees and their Spouses**. ECHS facilities have been granted to SSCOs/ Non Pensioner Pre-Mature Retirees. They must pay for OPD/ IPD/ Investigations in ECHS empanelled hospitals and seek reimbursement @ 75% of total admissible expenditure for personnel having more than 10 years of service and @ 50% of total admissible expenditure for personnel having less than or equal to 10 years of service, respectively. They will have to make full payment first to the empanelled hospitals and then claim laid down percentage from ECHS on reimbursement basis as per CGHS rates. Claims will need to be submitted to parent ECHS Polyclinic with claim marked in bold red 'Reimbursement Claim – Non Pensioner (SSCOs/ PMR)'. They can utilize non empanelled hospitals in emergency as per norms applicable to other ECHS members. The applicant must register under the category of SSCOs retiree at www.echs.gov.in.

29. <u>**Grant of Medical Facilities – Girl Cadet Instructor**</u>. Girl Cadet Instructors (GCI-1) of NCC are eligible for medical treatment under ECHS. (Auth - Central Organisation, ECHS letter No. B/49708-GC/AG/ECHS/2020 dated 27 Jan 2020)

30. <u>Grant of ECHS Membership to the Ex-sailors appointed prior 03.07.1976 and</u> <u>Discharged on or after 03.07.1976 on Expiry of 10 Years of Service</u>. DESW has agreed to categorise the ex-sailors, who meet the twin conditions for getting membership of ECHS, as "Normal Pension drawing ECHS beneficiaries".

31. Empanelment of Hospitals / Nursing Homes and Diagnostic Centres for ECHS.
 150 Hospitals / Nursing Homes and Diagnostic Centres for ECHS are empanelled across the

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country vide Gol letter No. 22B(01)/2020/WE/D(Res-1) dated 24 Feb 20. This letter is available in public domain and is available on DESA website.

33. **Extension of ECHS Facilities**. The Government has extended ECHS facilities to the following: -

(a) Pensioners of Assam Rifles.

(b) World War II Veterans, Emergency Commissioned Officers, Short Service Commissioned Officers and also premature retirees, although all of them are non-pensioners. It may be noted that the facility has been extended only to their spouses and not to other dependents.

34. <u>Amendment to Provisions Regarding Supply of Medicines to ECHS</u> <u>Beneficiaries</u>. Gol, MoD has sanctioned reimbursement of medicines and consumables to ECHS beneficiaries for a maximum period of 15 days at a time, subject to maximum value of medicines and consumables not exceeding Rs. 25,000/- each time under general conditions and 30 days at a time subject to maximum value of medicines and consumables not exceeding Rs. 75,000/- each time (Rs 2, 00,000/- for cancer drugs) under special conditions. This would be subject to obtaining NAC from OIC ECHS Polyclinic.

35. <u>**Treatment of Senior Citizens**</u>. ECHS beneficiaries of undermentioned ages will continue to be given priority for medical attendance at Polyclinic including consultation, check-up and issue of medicine.

- (a) Males 75 yrs & above
- (b) Females 70 yrs & above

36. <u>ECHS Facilities for Persons with Disability (PWD)</u>. Persons with Disability holding White Cards are entitled for medical care through ECHS as per Central Organisation, ECHS letter B/49701-PR/AG/ECHS/2020 dated 10 Aug 2020. In this regard, it is clarified that no

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additional documents may need to be furnished by the beneficiaries for treatment in any empanelled hospital. In case any clarifications are needed, beneficiaries are free to contact on following emails:-

38. <u>Exception Handling Measures for Aadhar Card due to Non Capturing of</u> <u>Biometrics of Age Related Issues</u>. The 'Aadhar Exception Mechanism' in the online application for ECHS Smart Card has been implemented for those beneficiaries who are unable to get Aadhar made due to age related issues or medical conditions.

39. <u>Air Travel</u>. Air travel for stretcher patients of Port Blair for immediate evacuation to mainland and oxygen support during the air travel would be admissible and the reimbursement proposal would be considered on merits of individual case by MoD (Finance/ Pension) wherever medical authorities certify that air travel/ oxygen was essential.

40. <u>ECHS Facilities whilst Dealing with Marital Discord Cases</u>. Central Organisation ECHS had promulgated a policy regarding handling of marital discord cases vide letter No B/49701-PR/AG/ECHS/2018 dated 28 Sep 18 (available on ECHS website echs.gov.in). A judicially separated wife of a veteran is eligible to apply for ECHS card for a limited period of one year or till resolution/ divorce, whichever is earlier. The same would be renewed in case of status quo beyond one year. Central Organisation ECHS has now promulgated procedure to apply for the card.

42. Directorate General Resettlement works towards effective resettlement of the ex-Servicemen through imparting training and empowering them for a host of employment and self-employment opportunities. The details have been uploaded on DESA website and are also available on DGR website <u>www.dgrindia.com</u>.

43. <u>**Registration**</u>. Registration with DGR is a mandatory requirement to avail any opportunity of employment through DGR/ Self Employment Scheme. The following may be noted:-

(a) <u>Online Registration</u>. Registration in DGR by eligible ESM – Officers/JCOs/ORs and equivalents in the three Services is now online through the interactive official website of DGR. It is a onetime procedure and is common to all schemes managed by DGR. Requisite supporting documents (details available on DGR website) are also to be uploaded online. In case the documents are not uploaded within one and a half month of registration the provisional registration shall stand cancelled.

(b) <u>Change of Scheme (one time only</u>). Registered officers can submit an application/e-mail to the concerned Directorates in DGR with a copy to 'Employment–II Dte' in case he/she desires to opt for a change of scheme.

(c) <u>**Reservation**</u>. Reservation is provided in Central Civil Services, Central PSUs and Nationalized Banks for ESM to the extent mentioned in relevant Govt. of India orders on the subject.

44. DGR is mandated to organize and conduct Pre Release Courses (PRCs) for retiring/retired service personnel for enabling them to improve their Civil Sector employability. Eligibility and terms & conditions are available on DGR Website <u>www.dgrindia.com</u>. Details are as follows:-

(a) DGR sponsored resettlement training courses are conducted for retired/retiring Officers. 60% course fee is borne by DGR and 40% share of course fee is paid by the participating officer.

(b) DGR sponsored resettlement training courses are conducted for retired/retiring JCOs/OR and equivalent. 100% course fee is borne by DGR.

(c) Approved programme for schedule of Resettlement courses Aug 21 to Mar 22 for retiring/ retired officers is uploaded on DESA website.

Pension Related Issues

57. Option for Fixation of Pay on Promotion from the Date of Next Increment (DNI) on Grant of MACP (Mechanism iro Sailors Released from 01 Jan 16 to 31 Jul 21). As a one-time exercise following actions are to be carried out for the sailors released from 01 Jan 16 to 31 Jul 21 (DPA letter PA/6313 dated 02 Jul 21 is uploaded on DESA website):-

(i) **Issuance of BOIC**. CABS is to forward BOIC issued for grant of MACP iro Sailors released from 01 Jan 16 to 31 Jul 21, to NPO by 30 Sep 21.

(ii) **<u>Fixation of Pay</u>** NPO is to fix pay using best option for the released sailor, suomoto quoting this policy letter as authority, by 31 Mar 22 view following:-

(aa) Data for calculating best option is of historical nature and is available with NPO. Thus NPO will be able to calculate best option for all individuals.

(ab) Difficult to reach and obtain option form from each and every released personnel.

(ac) View ongoing COVID restrictions, mail management is not fully functional on a pan India basis.

58. Know your Pension Payment Order (PPO).

(a) Check correctness of "Name" of self and spouse.

(b) Check correctness and full "Date of Birth" of self and spouse are mentioned in the PPO.

- (c) Check correctness of "Rank" indicated in the PPO.
- (d) Check correctness of "Bank details" (Account No. and Branch address).
- (e) Original copy of PPO to be kept safely.

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59. Digital Life Certificate for pensioner's scheme of the Gol, known as **Jeevan Pramaan**, seeks to address the requirement of personally being present in front of the disbursing agency by digitising the whole process of securing the life certificate. It aims to streamline the process of getting this certificate and making it trouble free and easier for our pensioners. The steps to be followed by the pensioners to generate Life Certificate are given below:-

(a) <u>Step 1</u>. Download mobile app. Alternatively, visit nearest Jeevan Pramaan Centre to get registered. Provide necessary information like Aadhar No, PPO No, Bank Account No, Bank name and Mobile No.

(b) <u>Step 2</u>. Provide your biometrics, either a finger print or Iris scan and authenticate yourself.

(c) <u>Step 3</u>. After successful authentication a SMS acknowledgement is sent to your mobile no, including your Jeevan Pramaan certificate ID. The certificate is stored in the Life Certificate Repository and is available anytime and anywhere.

(d) **<u>Step 4</u>**. You can download a *pdf* copy of the certificate from the Jeevan Pramaan website by providing the Jeevan Pramaan ID.

(e) **<u>Step 5</u>**. The Pension Disbursing Agency can access the life certificate from the Jeevan Pramaan website and download the same.

60. Issuance of E-PPO for Pre-16 Pensioners/ Family Pensioners

(a) PCDA(N) Mumbai has commenced generation of e-PPOs in respect of Retd officers/ Ex-sailors, who retired or were released from service between 01 Nov 1985 and 31 Dec 2015. The e-PPOs generated and issued by PCDA (N), Mumbai have been uploaded on the NAVPEN website, accessible through link <u>https://www.indiannavy.nic.in/navpen/eppo_download</u>.

(b) PCDA(N) Mumbai is still in the process of generating e-PPOs in a progressive manner. The e-PPOs generated will be uploaded on the NAVPEN website as and when received from PCDA(N) Mumbai. A list of Service Numbers whose Pre-2016 e-PPOS have been uploaded on the website can also be viewed at <u>https://www.indiannavy.nic.in/navpen/list-pre-2016-e-ppos-generated</u>. Individuals may check for the service No (Without Service Alphabet) available in the list (both Retd Officers & Ex-Sailors) from the mentioned link which will be updated from time to time. Further, individual whose service No. is included in the list may go to the link <u>https://www.indiannavy.nic.in/navpen/eppo_download</u> and download the e-PPOs by entering the Service No.(including suffix Alphabet) and Date of Birth in the format provided.

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(c) In case of any clarification and discrepancy/ error observed in the e-PPO, the pensioner are requested to seek clarification from PCDA(N) Mumbai on e-mail ID <u>pcdanavysuomoto.dad@gov.in</u>.
